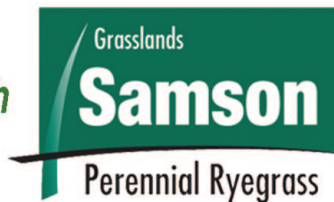


SAMSON perennial ryegrass

wide adaption*

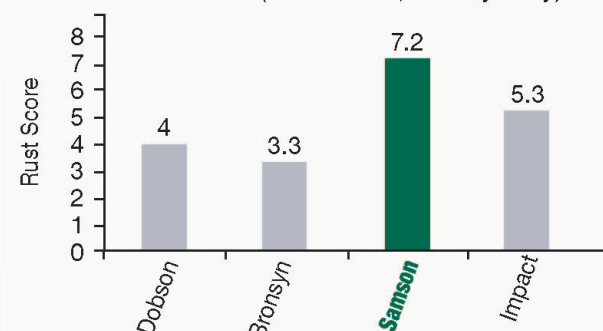


SAMSON is a medium tillered perennial ryegrass with rapid and vigorous establishment. SAMSON has the added advantages of high summer yields of rust tolerant forage and consistently performs in the top bracket of perennials in nationwide trials.

SAMSON was bred by AgResearch Grasslands from persistent plants that showed superior production, were crown rust tolerant and able to perform well in drier environments.

Plants were selected from old ryegrass pastures in seven regions with moderate to high rainfall.

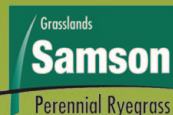
With a medium flowering date SAMSON should be used as the base perennial ryegrass in dairy pastures and high input in beef and sheep farms.

Recommended pasture mixes:

Milk production - Ideal pasture for use under irrigation or in high spring/summer rainfall areas. SAMSON's rust tolerance ensures high quality feed in these situations. (SAMSON, PRESTIGE white clover, TRIBUTE white clover, WILL white clover, TONIC plantain)



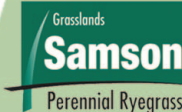
