

TIMOTHY

Timothy is a valuable quality component for pastures in high fertility, high moisture retentive soils in reliable summer moist areas (900mm minimum average annual rainfall).

It's use increases summer quality through excellent summer production, high palatability even in seedhead stage, and compatibility with clovers and herbs.

Timothy is most often sown at 1-3kg/ha in mixes of ryegrass dominant pastures, or at 5-8kg/ha alone as a specialist summer pasture. Some are better suited to grazing, while other timothy's are hay types and not as persistent under grazing.



VIKING timothy



VIKING is a densely tillered, early season timothy for use in grazing systems.

For identification purposes, Timothy has dark blue-green, densely tufted, hairless, smooth leaves, rounded tillers with swollen bulb-like bases, and a "pipe cleaner" seedhead.

Recommended pastures mixes:

Summer moist perennial pasture - VIKING, CANNON, PRESTIGE, WILL, COLENZO, TONIC
