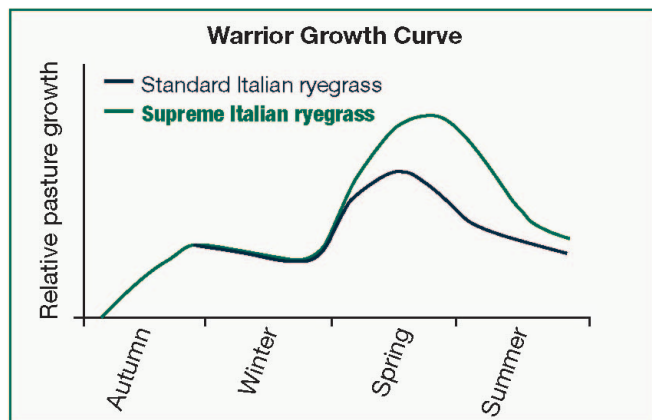

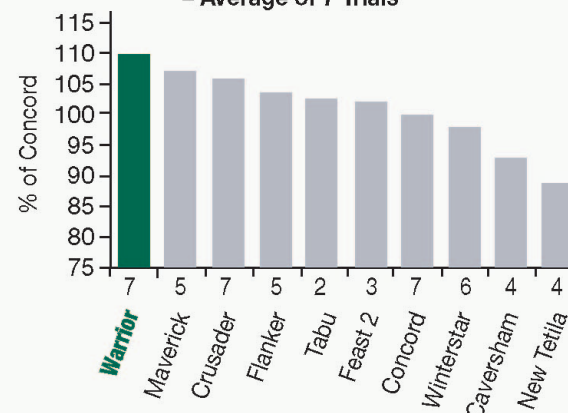

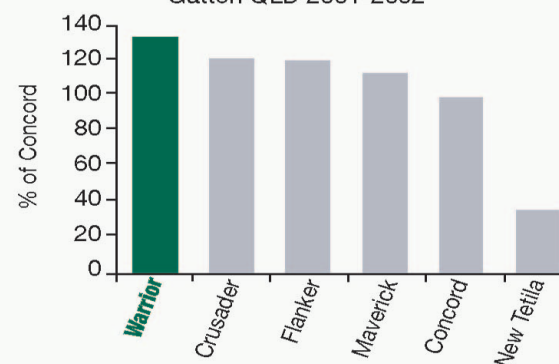


Dry Matter Production of Warrior in First Year
